3. Club History

A short History of Muskerry Golf Club

Muskerry Golf Club is one of the oldest and longest established Golf Clubs in the Cork Area having been founded in 1907. It is located at Carrigrohane Co Cork. The Cork & Muskerry Light railway which ran beside the course, provided ready access to the course for early members from Cork, Coachford, Blarney and Donoghamore and was the main reason that the course and clubhouse is located where it has been for over 100 years.

Throughout its long history the Club and its members has won virtually every major amateur team and individual competition in Irish Golf and is justly proud of its unique sporting heritage.

5. How to download ClubNet

1. Download the ClubNet App for the Apple Store or Google Play Store
2. You will be provided a list of golf courses near your location, choose Muskerry GC.
3. Once your subscription is paid, your account will be activated and you can create an account with your email and create a password.



6. How to book a tee time

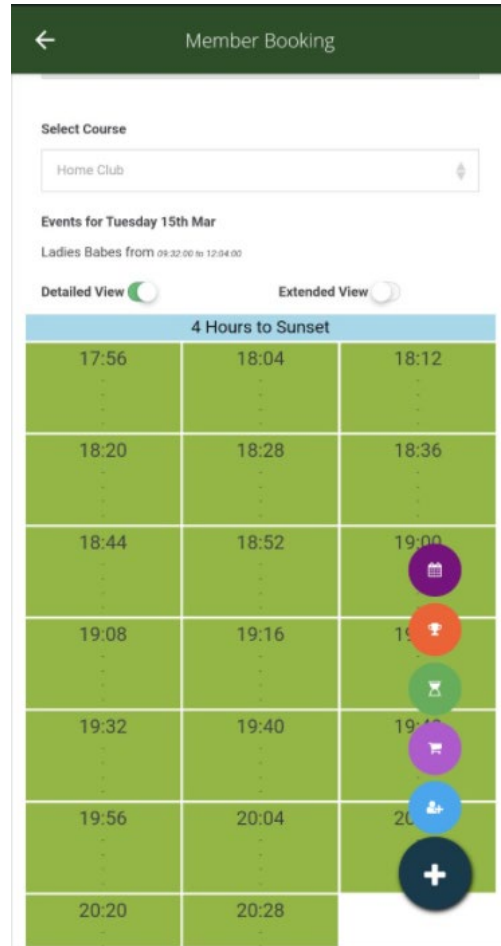
1. Open the ClubNet App
2. Select the Tee Times Icon
3. Select the Member Booking option
4. Toggle to the day which you would like to play
5. Select an available tee time slot and enter your name (automatically populates as “Yourself”) plus any additional playing partners.

Frost Delays

From time to time the course may be delayed in opening due to frost. Muskerry has its own micro-climate and generally is 3-5C colder than the city in the morning time so I can take longer to thaw than expected.

At present, the timesheet stands as a result of a frost delay, meaning whoever is first out on the original timesheet as the right to the tee box when the course opens following a delay.

7. Top up your ClubNet Account

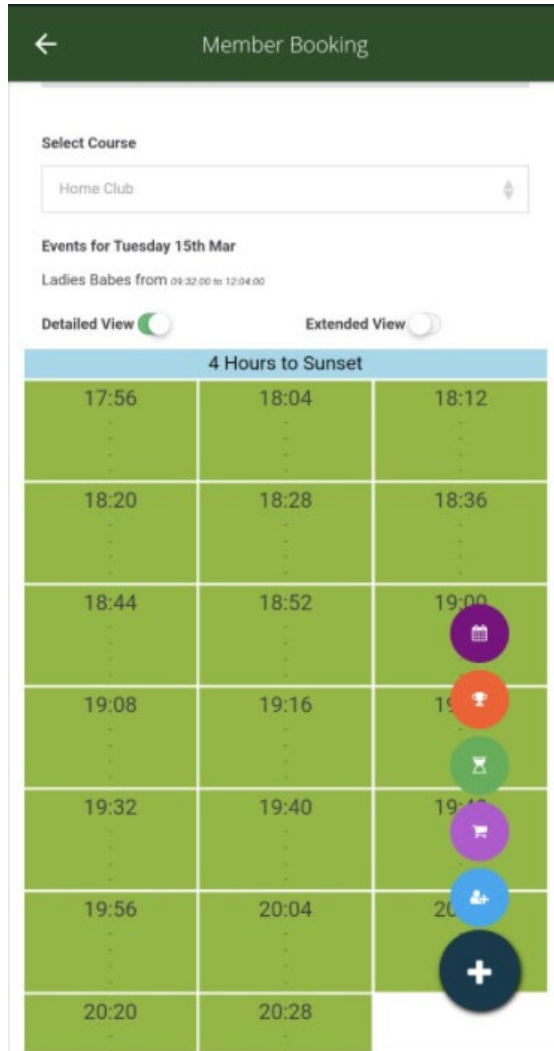


In order to play in competition you will require money in your ClubNet purse. The following are steps to allow you to top-up your purse:

1. Toggle to any day in the ClubNet App, as seen in the image.
2. Click the + Icon in the bottom right hand corner of the screen.
3. Click the purple icon of the shopping trolley
4. This will bring you to the payment screen where you can top-up your purse by between €20 - €100.

Note: Competition fees are typically €5, with the exception of majors which are €10.

8. Opening times for timesheets



Tee times are released 9 days in advance at 7.30pm.

E.G. For a Saturday, the tee times are released the Thursday of the week prior.

N.B.: once you click on a tee time, the window is only open for 45 seconds so ensure you're prompt with booking your time as you may lose your slot.

Note: particularly at weekends, the early morning tee times are popular, ensure to be ready at 7.30pm to book your slot.

Waiting List Function

If you fail to obtain your desired tee time you may enter your name on the waiting list for a specified time period. The steps to which are as follows:

1. Toggle to the desired day of play
2. Click the + Icon in the bottom right hand corner of the screen
3. Click the green icon of a timer which will open the waiting list pop up screen
4. Select your preferred time range
5. Click Add To List

9. How to look up results.

Master Score Board is the website used to publish the results of club competitions.

You will be provided with a password upon payment of your subscription. If you have not received your password or have forgotten your password please contact the manager: manager@muskerrygolfclub.com

There are two methods to view the results, via the ClubNet App and also via the Master Score Board website.

ClubNet App

1. Open the ClubNet App
2. Click the Members Icon
3. Click Results
4. Enter Details

1. Go to www.masterscoreboard.co.uk
2. Type Muskerry Golf Club into the search bar
3. Click “Find Club”
4. Click on Muskerry Golf Club
5. Enter Details

On Master Score Board website, once you have logged in, select the option of Handicap List on the top bar.

Here you can search for your handicap index, and those of your peers.

You can filter the screen by clicking the Handicap Index heading, this will give you the list in order of handicap.

11. Top Up Bar Account

- Your Golf Ireland card can be used to purchase food and drink in the Bar & Restaurant.
- You can top up your account at the bar at any time.
- There is a discount on drinks in the bar when you pay with your Golf Ireland card (~5%).

12. How to download Golf Ireland App.

1. Download the Golf Ireland App for the Apple Store or Google Play Store
2. Create an account or login in if you have previously established an account.
3. This will give you a live feed of your Handicap Index and a history of all the rounds played.
4. There is an “add friends” function which allows you to track the scores of your peers.

- There are 4 buggies currently available to rent. At a cost of €20 per buggy. To be booked in advance.

16. Course Etiquette

- Replace divots
- Repair pitch marks
- Rake bunkers
- Hit a provisional ball when in doubt to avoid slow play
- Don't walk on the intended line of your playing partner putt whilst on the green.
- Don't stand directly behind your playing partner whilst they are hitting a shot.
- Wear appropriate clothing
